## Animal Food Bank of the Lehigh Valley

The Animal Food Bank keeps companion animals in loving homes and prevents their surrender to the shelter system by supplying families with pet food in times of economic distress.

## Who we are

The Animal Food Bank is a 501(c)(3) corporation serving the Lehigh Valley since 2009. We are staffed completely by volunteers, none of whom are paid. We are not a government agency.

Our volunteers solicit donations of food, transport food to warehouses and to our office, and distribute food to pet owners in need.

We also work closely with area animal welfare groups and veterinarians to direct the community to low-cost resources.

We donate food to area no-kill shelters, rescues, and feral cat colonies when surplus food is available.

## If you need food

You can register your pets on one of our distribution days on the second, third and fourth Fridays of each month, between 1 p.m. and 5 p.m. We are NOT open the first or fifth Fridays of the month. Our distribution location is: Fowler Family Center, 511 E. Third St., Bethlehem, Pa.

The Animal Food Bank **requires** the following before distributing food.

1. A government-issued **photo ID with proof of residence**, such as a utility bill.
2. **Proof of income**, such as a paystub, a tax return, or a statement from Social Security or other government agency.
3. A **spay/neuter certificate** for each pet, proof of a **current rabies vaccination** for each dog or cat, and of a **current dog license** for each dog for whom you are seeking assistance

You must comply with local ordinances on number of pets in a household and cannot add any pets once you have registered.
