1) Toni Lee Febbo, Director of HR Services

- The last couple of meetings there have been questions about salary benchmarking. In the early 2000's we started using a Market Reference System. We look at the salary surveys and then look at our salary compensation charts. Each year we do a study that reports back on how competitive our salaries are and we share this with top administration at Lehigh. We have a company that tracks salary surveys each year. We have over the years made large investments in bringing salaries up. Last one was done in '05, '06' and '07. We will look at specific jobs and make adjustments. We routinely review the police department for example. We have done outside studies for them.
- If we are looking at positions that are unique to Higher Education we will be looking at regional institutions with graduate program.

- Position Descriptions can be changed but you must get your Supervisor involved in the process.
- How can we remain competitive in keeping the talent here when they have an offer from another institution? This is all budget driven. We cannot assume it is the exact same job. Every job has its unique features. Lehigh makes very few counter offers.
